The Purpose

- Elect County Executive Committees
(They represent the County Party)
- Elect State Central Executive Committee
(They represent the State Party)

(State Central Executive Committee Elects 11 delegates to the National Convention)

Precinct Convention

- When:** Saturday April 5, 2008 at 10:00 am
- Where:** Your Polling Place
- What Happens:** Any registered Democrat in that precinct may run, attend, nominate and vote for a man (any age), a woman (any age) and youth (age 18-35) to serve as the Precinct Committee.
- Why:** The three people elected here then proceed to County (or L.D.) Convention **April 12th** at a location determined by the County Chair.

County/L.D. Convention

- When:** Saturday April 12, 2008 at 10:00 am
- Where:** A place determined by the County Chair
- What Happens:** The Precinct Committee persons (man, and youth) who were elected at each Precinct Convention meet and carry out two tasks.
1. Elect the delegates to the State Convention
 2. Elect the County Executive Committee
- Why:** The people elected here at the County (or L.D.) Convention to be delegates to the State Convention will then go to the State Convention on **Saturday, June 7th.**

The State Convention

- When:** Saturday June 7, 2008 at 2:00pm
- Where:** To Be Determined
- What Happens:** All the delegates elected from each County (or L. D.) Convention will meet and elect the State Central Committee.
- Why:** The State Central Committee will then have their first State Central Meeting.

Details for electing State Central Committee

- Step 1: All delegates elected from the County (or L. D.) Convention will caucus together in their perspective Congressional Districts at The State Convention to elect State Central members.
- Step 2: All delegates elected from County (or L. D.) Conventions will all caucus together to elect State Central members at large and elect the Democratic Party Chair.

State Central Committee Meeting

- When:** Saturday June 7, 2008 at 3:00pm
- Where:** To Be Determined
- What Happens:** The newly elected State Central members have their first State Central Committee meeting.
- Why:** The newly elected *State Central Committee* will elect 10 people as delegates to the National Convention in Denver, **August 25-28, 2008.**

County/L.D. Caucus for National Convention

- When:** Saturday May 31, 2008 at 10:00 am
- Where:** A place determined by the County Chair.
- What Happens:** Any registered Democrat in that county may run, attend, nominate and vote for people to be sent as delegates to their Congressional District Caucus on **June 7, 2008.**
- Why:** The people elected here as delegates will attend the Congressional District Caucus on **June 7th.**

Congressional District Caucus for National Convention

- When:** Saturday June 7, 2008 at 10:00 am
- Where:** To Be Determined
- What Happens:** The people elected from the Legislative District Caucus will meet here to nominate and to elect the delegates to the National Convention.
- Why:** A total of 36 delegates and alternates will be elected by all six Congressional Districts. Allocation per CD dependent on % of CD gubernatorial vote to total vote 2007.
1. 6 from the 1st CD
4 from the 2nd CD
8 from the 3rd CD
6 from the 4th CD
5 from the 5th CD
7 from the 6th CD
 2. The Party Chair will nominate two one of whom will be elected by the convention to serve as a Nat'l Delegates
